REPORTS

A. President

- Nothing to report

B. General Manager

- Clubhouse remains closed at this time due to Covid.
- The Fall Trivia night and Garage Sale were cancelled due to COVID.
- Trunk or Treat has been reworked as a backwards Treat in the Trunk event.
- As of today, 24 homeowners have not paid their dues in full. Three lots will receive a lien if they do not pay by October 1.
- There will be five two-year board positions open in the November election.
- The bylaw amendment passed. Approximately 30% of eligible homeowners submitted ballots with 476 ballots being cast. 351 were in favor/125 ballots were in opposition, with the amendment passing with a 73.7% approval.
- The office contract with Ricoh for equipment rentals is up for renewal. The office will receive additional bids before renewing.
- Nate Rebeck moved from Asst. Treasurer to Treasurer, for the remainder of 2020.
- State Senator Dayna Polehanki's office has been contacted to assist us in closing an unjustified unemployment claim.

C. Maintenance

- Monthly preventative maintenance was completed at both clubhouses.
- Wayne is in the process of cleaning out the garage.
- Plumberz was out on Sept 15 to begin the process of removing calcium build-up from the backwash drain pipe at Gainsborough.
- Pest Masters was called to remove a Black Faced Hornet's nest.
- Clearwater pools has been contracted to replace both leaking filters at the Gainsborough pool and replace the breaking tile and coping stones at the Hanford pools.

- Parris Construction will be providing an updated quote for the Gainsborough shower room floor project.
- Art's Tree Service was called to look at tree issues on Glenhurst, Merrie Park and the east side of Gainsborough Clubhouse. Two areas will require trimming.
- Clean Cut walked the commons area and is sending a proposal to replace the eleven trees that have been removed.
- **Motion made by Jeff Barszcz to increase the maintenance manager's allowance to \$1000 over discretionary spending for completion of the Gainsborough plumbing job. Supported by: Bob Parker, All in Favor: Motion Carried.**
