Only homeowners may purchase guest passes and they must accompany their guests to the pool. All guests must check in at the gate.

We hope you have an opportunity to enjoy the pools this summer. Our staff has been working hard to ensure a safe, clean and friendly environment.

- The pool is not available for private parties we do not rent out the pool. Therefore when you rent the clubhouse you and your guests do not have access to the pools.
- Please enjoy your snacks outside the pool area. We do not allow food on the deck or in the shower rooms.
- Guest passes are required for all guests (a guest is anyone who does not live at your home). A resident may bring up to six guests at one time.

• Parents must register childcare providers with the Office (the pool personnel are not able to handle registration at the pool). <u>YOU MUST REGISTER CHILDCARE</u> <u>PROVIDERS EVERY YEAR</u>

• Red Dot Test for children ages 9-11 will be given on M-W-F from 8-9 PM at the Gainsborough Pool. Please pre-register your child before 7 PM. A limited number of tests are done each evening.

- Disposable diapers are not allowed in the pool.
- Small plastic pool toys (fits in the palm of your hand) with no sharp edges or removable parts are allowed in the pool. Please no dolls with hair, sharp edges or large balls.

• Children under the age of 6 <u>must</u> be accompanied <u>in the water</u> by an adult or qualified helper.

OUR LIFEGUARD STAFF IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL PATRONS AND TO PROVIDE FIRST RESPONDER CARE. <u>IT IS THE</u> <u>PARENT'S RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF THEIR</u> <u>CHILDREN.</u>

Things to Remember

Storm Drain Reminder

As a reminder, the storm drains in homeowners' backyards need to be maintained by the homeowner/surrounding homeowners who benefit from that drain. Homeowners have often shared in the cost of any necessary repairs. Tree roots and other debris can cause issues and blockages with drainage. Periodic maintenance checks on the drains are recommended. A local plumber can do these maintenance checks. With the aging trees in the neighborhood, it is a good idea to be sure the drains are free of roots before problems occur. It is also highly recommended that no plantings are put in the easement or near the storm drain/line. Trees may need to be removed if their roots are a recurring problem to the storm drain system.

Keeping Sunflower Safe

- **Recreational Facilities close at 9pm.** This means no basketball, pickle ball or tennis after that time.
- No loitering in parks or parking lots. Please enjoy our parks, walk your dogs, run, ride your bikes with your friends or family. However, the police will be looking for individuals or groups of people who are just "hanging out" and ticket them for loitering.
- Call the police if you see any suspicious activity at 734-394-5400.
- Call the Sunflower Office after you have contacted the police.

Community Mailboxes

If you lose your mailbox key or have any issue with the community mailboxes, contact the Canton Post Office for a replacement key or help with your issue.

Fireworks

Fireworks are NOT allowed in any commons areas.

Sec. 46-264. Discharge of novelties, lowimpact fireworks and consumer fireworks.

- (a) Except in the case of a permit issued by the township under section 46-266, consumer fireworks shall not be ignited, discharged, or used by any person at any time, except after 11:00 a.m. on the following dates and times:
 - (1) December 31 until 1:00 a.m. on January 1.
 - (2) The Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Memorial Day until 11:45 p.m. on each of those days.
 - (3) June 29 to July 4 until 11:45 p.m. on each of those days.
 - (4) July 5, if that date it a Friday or Saturday, until 11:45 p.m.
 - (5) The Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Labor Day until 11:45 p.m. on each of those days.
- (b) When permitted, consumer fireworks shall not be ignited or discharged on public property, school property, church property, or property of another person without that organization's or person's written permission to use consumer fireworks on the premises.
- (c) No fireworks shall be ignited or discharged within 70 feet of any building, or on any public street.
- (d) Minors shall be prohibited from possessing, using, igniting or discharging consumer fireworks.
- (e) No person shall use low-impact or consumer fireworks while under the influence of alcoholic liquor or a controlled substance or both.

- The courts may not be used for bike riding or rollerblading as the surfaces are a special composition and any other use besides basketball, tennis or pickleball damages the court

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
